Identify several key concepts or ideas presented in the week's original texts that you consider central to understanding the readings, make sure to include a page number to reference these ideas. Feel free to also include notes or page number references to areas you do not understand or struggle with, for us to discuss in class.
- 3. Finally, based on your reading of the Seidman text AND your own understanding, explain the concepts in your own words.

Unless noted in the syllabus, weekly reading notes are due each Tuesday. They must be submitted on Moodle before the start of class.
